We are a member of the national PONY (Protect Our Nations Youth) Baseball and Softball organization. Our program is designed to provide an experience in youth baseball and softball that will help young people grow into healthier and happier adults. Registrations – In order to facilitate the registration process, fill out the Registration Form and the Player and Parent/Fan Conduct forms available from the web site. Deliver them to either CVAC or to the registration table at Play It Again Sports on Jan 12, 19, 26, or Feb 2, between Noon and 4 PM, **or mail them along with a check for the appropriate amount to CVAC, Attn: Registrar, P.O. Box 58362 Renton, WA 98058. Registration closes February 2, 2008.**

Official age is as of **April 30, 2008** (baseball) and **January 1, 2008** (softball). Baseball/Softball uniforms are provided for Shetland through Bronco leagues. Teams in Pony through Palomino will receive \$25.00 per player for a hat allowance. Basic team equipment is provided. Players need to provide their own fielding gloves and personal equipment. Additional safety equipment is allowed and recommended. Payment is required at time of registration by cash, money order or personal check made out to CVAC. The Family Discount Plan applies to those families with more than one player in the club. Under this plan, registration fees are reduced \$10.00 for a second child, \$20.00 for a third child, and \$5.00 for each additional child. From March 1st to March 28th you may receive a refund, less \$15.00 filing fee. No refunds will be given after season play has begun on March 27, 2006. All refund requests must be made in writing to: CVAC, Attn: Registrar, P.O. Box 58362 Renton, WA 98058. There is also a \$15.00 returned check fee for both the registration and fundraiser. A photocopy of your child's birth certificate (if not already on file), a signed medical release on the registration form, and a signed Parent and Player Code of Conduct are all required at time of registration. Without these documents your child will not be placed on a team.

Financial Commitment – In order for CVAC to provide a quality program to its members, additional income must be generated through means other than registration fees. These other means include team sponsorships, outfield signs, and our league fundraiser. Each player is also required to participate in the annual fundraiser. Once again, we will be offering Seattle Mariner game packages as prizes. Each team/coach is responsible for acquiring a minimum of \$200.00 in sponsorship funds by the second week of regular season play. Each \$200.00 sponsor receives a small backstop sign at our home field, a team photo/plaque, a note on our website, and a team hat. Sponsors who donate \$500.00 also receive a 4x8 foot sign on our home field outfield fence.
